KWMR, our homegrown radio station, celebrated its 15-year anniversary thanks to the significant and vital support of our members, volunteers, programmers, staff, board and advisory board. Continuing its mission of building and sustaining community, KWMR offers high quality locally-produced programming, carefully selected pre-produced shows, and emergency news reports to keep you current. Community radio in West Marin is alive and thriving at KWMR with some 90 local programmers.

Exciting news! After an eleven-year quest for FCC licensing, KWMR now has a third frequency that improves our coverage in West Marin. On Friday, May 16, KWMR began broadcasting at 92.3 FM from Mt. Barnabe, reaching the San Geronimo Valley and Inverness Park. A big welcome to our new Valley listeners.
